**LINC MECHANICAL TEAMS UP WITH WRIGHT STATE
UNIVERSITY ON ENERGY EFFICIENT PROJECT**

*Wright State University Goes Green While Saving Energy Dollars
with Linc Mechanical's Bundled Energy Solutions Project*



DAYTON, OHIO – October 12, 2009 – Linc Mechanical is implementing a Bundled Energy Solutions project for Wright State University that will provide the school with more than \$1.3 million in annual energy savings.

The project, which began on Wright State University's campus on June 22, 2009, will significantly reduce energy consumption in 26 different facilities. In addition to reducing the University's annual utility, operational, and maintenance costs, Linc's program will help the University comply with Ohio State House Bill #251, which requires the school to institute a plan to reduce energy usage by 20% by 2014.

Linc Mechanical's 10-year payback is projected to save Wright State University an estimated \$13.5-\$14.5 million over the life of the project.

The scope of work covers the installation of new lighting, demand-control ventilation, and restroom exhaust controls, as well as retro-commissioning and boiler replacement. Select buildings will also incorporate green upgrades, such as thermal solar heat recovery and water conservation.

“This is a huge win for both Wright State University and Linc Mechanical,” said Linc Mechanical General Manager Greg Hahn. “It took a true team effort of local and national resources working together to turn this plan into action. It will be a pleasure to work closely with the staff at Wright State as we implement the project, and we are looking forward to a positive, long-term relationship with the University.”

Included in the more than two dozen facilities, on which Linc’s service professionals will be working, are several residence halls, academic centers, and student recreation areas. The project should take 14-18 months to complete and be finished by the end of 2010. Given Linc’s close proximity to the University, all jobs created as a result of this project will be filled locally.

“We’re excited about working with Linc in the creation of a new level of energy efficiency and comfort in many of our buildings on campus,” said Wright State University Director of Physical Plant Jeff Trick. “We anticipate this project will greatly enhance daily activities and operations for our students, faculty members, and administrators. The cost savings to the University will also be very beneficial.”

“We embrace the opportunity to use our energy-saving expertise in the education market as a way of helping Wright State University reduce its operating costs,” said Linc Network, LLC President & CEO Scott Giacobbe. “Our program eliminates a lot of the risks for the school, and since this project pays for itself from the savings, there are no additional costs involved.
